RECREATION PROGRAMS AND EVENTS

YOUTH MEMBERSHIP IS \$36 PER YEAR Buy your membership and save throughout the year on programs and activities.

NEW YEAR'S LOCK IN, DECEMBER 31 At the Youth Center, ages 7-12, from 9:00 p.m. on December 31 to 8:00 a.m. on January 1. Cost is \$15 for members and \$25 for nonmembers.

TEEN NIGHTS Every Tuesday from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

SKATE NIGHT, DECEMBER 3 Cost is \$3 for members and \$5 for nonmembers. Bring your friends and skate from 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

CHEERLEADING REGISTRATION THROUGH DECEMBER 3 Cost is \$90 per child and includes a uniform. This is a coed activity for ages 5-14. Practice begins December 6. A valid physical must be on file at registration.

BASKETBALL REGISTRATION, THROUGH DECEMBER 3 Cost is \$31 for ages 3-4 and includes a jersey and \$41 for ages 5-14 and includes a uniform. Practice begins January 3. A valid physical must be on file at registration. The awards Ceremony is March 8.

INSTRUCTIONAL CLASSES

PIANO Lessons include instruction, sight reading, ear training, composing, computer lab, theory, games, and reward center. Wednesday and Friday, ages 5-18, \$55 month.

TAE KWON DO Focus on self-defense, self-control, and self-discipline. Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, ages 5-18, \$46 month.

MIXED MARTIAL ARTS Combination of soft and hard style self-defense, sparring, and weapons. Monday, and Wednesday, ages 4-18, \$40 month. Taught by Master Gloria Olson in Bldg 520.

DANCE Designed to give students instruction in various dance styles every Thursday and Friday for ages 3-18. Cost is \$25/\$35 month.

JUDO Grappling sport involving throwing, pinning, choking (ages 13 & up) and arm locks (17 & up). Competition available at all levels. Wednesday or Friday, ages 5-18, \$25 month.

GUITAR Learn to play the 6 string guitar as well as music theory. Styles include classical, rock, blues, jazz, and country/folk. Classes are held every Tuesday. Cost is \$68/month (2 months or 8 week sessions). Students must bring their own guitar.



ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES

GIVE PARENTS A BREAK, DECEMBER 18 From 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., free child care for active duty families that have a deployed spouse, special needs children, and families in crisis. Requires a referral from the Airman & Family Readiness Center and AF Form 1181. Child Development Center takes children ages 6 weeks - 5 years and the Youth Center takes ages Kindergarten - 12 years. Held the third Saturday of each month with alternating times. If space is available, GPAB will accommodate individuals without a referral. The fee without a referral is \$15 with a completed AF Form 1181. Please register by December 14.

YOUTH EMPLOYMENT SKILLS PROGRAM (YES) On-base volunteer program for high school students sponsored by the Air Force Aid Society. This program offers students an opportunity to learn valuable work skills, "bank" dollar credits toward their post-secondary education, and have a positive impact on the base community. Earn \$4 in grant funding for every hour volunteered on base.
