**SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP FOR
COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF THE AIR FORCE GRADUATES**

Scholarship Amount: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to one individual.

Purpose of Scholarship: To encourage science and engineering oriented students to enroll in courses and complete programs at the undergraduate or graduate levels.

Use of Scholarship Funds: Scholarship funds may be used for the recipient to enroll in classes offered by Utah State University in the Ogden Center or Brigham City Campus, and/or classes offered through Independent/Online study. The funds may also be used to purchase books or other materials related to these classes.

Length of Scholarship Use: Scholarship funds must be committed within one calendar year of being awarded. Extension of eligibility may be requested.

Minimum Eligibility: Completion of CCAF Associate Degree with AFSC emphasis in Science or Engineering. “Technology” designated programs are also eligible for consideration for this scholarship.

Scholarship Award Presentation: The person selected to be the recipient of the \$500 scholarship will be recognized by a representative of Utah State University during the CCAF graduation ceremony.

Selection Process: Students interested in applying for the scholarship must complete the Application Packet, consisting of the USU-CCAF Scholarship Application Form and the documents listed below, and submit them no later than 4:00 pm, **SEPTEMBER 30, 2009**. No applications will be accepted after 4:00 pm that day. Applications may be personally delivered to: Gayle Mahler, USU Ogden Education Center Assistant Director, in the Base Education Office (Bldg. 383), between 1:30 and 4:00 pm each Tuesday through **SEPTEMBER 30, 2009**, or faxed to: (801) 626-8897. Applications can also be emailed to: Gayle.Mahler@usu.edu. The scholarship recipient will be determined by representatives from Utah State University after reviewing all completed applications.

Although financial need will be considered during the selection process, it will not be the sole criteria for selection. Selection priority will be given to those CCAF graduates who plan on pursuing a major or minor of Science or Engineering at Utah State University, which is offered at one of the USU Distance Education Centers in Ogden or Brigham City.

Application Packet will include:

- A copy of applicant’s CCAF WEB Progress Report.
- One to three letters of support or recommendation.
- Unofficial copies of transcripts from other colleges/universities if desired.
- Other information that supports your application, such as awards.

Use additional paper if necessary to complete the packet.
