Indoor Pool

Monday-Friday:
0500-1900 Lap Swim / 1200-1900 Open Swim

Sat-Sun: 1200-1900 Lap/Open Swim

Outdoor Pool (Adjacent to Club Hill)

Wednesday-Sunday

1200-1900 Open Swim/Lap Swim

Persons in Diapers/under 3 years of age:

1. Persons in diapers, under 3 years of age, or not potty-trained are not allowed to swim in large community pools.
2. Kids under the age of 5 that are not potty trained, are **ONLY ALLOWED IN THE KIDDIE POOL** at the outdoor pool during summer hours.

FREE-Masters Swimming Program

0600-0700..... Mon/Wed/Fri

FREE-Water Aerobics (deep/shallow)

1100 - 1200.....Mon/Wed/Fri
(No Class on Holidays/Family Days)

Pool Party:

\$35.00/hr from 1900-2100 (optional 3rd hour)

Must sign contract, pay when making reservation, and party must start at 1900.
2 Lifeguards will be provided for party.

Indoor/Outdoor Aquatic Facility

NOTICE: During reduced stall levels (open/lap swim), lifeguards may clear all swimmers every 50 minutes in order to provide lifeguard(s) with a 10 minute break. (AFI 34-110, para. 13.3.2)

Pool Policies:

1. Children 10 years of age or younger, and those ages 11-13 who cannot swim at least 12 meters, are under the “direct” supervision (Not Implied) of an individual (Not the Lifeguard) who is at least 18 years old. Parents/adult must be in the water interacting with their kids at all times. (AFI 34-110, para. 13.4.1-13.4.2.)
2. Persons in diapers or not potty trained & children under 3 years old are NOT allowed to swim. (HAFB Public Health Policy Letter)
3. NO Eating/drinking in pools and at pool edges. All food and drinks must be 10 feet from pool edges. ABSOLUTELY no glass containers in pool facility. (AFI 34-110, para 13.9.)
4. During open recreation swimming, only approved properly fitting US Coast Guard (USCG) personal flotation devices (PFD), types I, II, III, during open recreational swim periods. (AFI 34-110, para 13.7.1.)
5. Toys that act as a buoyancy/flotation device will not be allowed in the pool; i.e., inner-tubes, beach balls, etc. (AFI 34-110, para. 13.7.2.)

Pool Rules:

6. Any type of approved PFD is not permitted in the deep end. Flotation devices will be permitted in shallow water and an adult must be within arm’s reach of the child. Flotation devices such as inner-tubes and arm floats are not permitted.
7. All swimmers must wear proper swimming attire. (Prohibited swimming attire includes thongs, see-through attire, undergarments, and any type of jeans/shorts/cutoffs)
8. Walk at all times. No running at any time in and around the pool facility.
9. All patrons MUST shower with soap before entering the pool. Persons with open cuts, sores, bandages, colds, coughs or infected eyes are not permitted in the pool.
11. Spitting, spouting, or blowing of nose into the pool or onto pool deck is strictly prohibited.
12. Improper public display of affection and foul/abusive language is strictly prohibited.
13. Dangerous practices are prohibited: No climbing, sitting, or hanging on diving boards/stairs (rails). No diving in shallow water, swimming in the diving area when divers are present, double bounce; or dunk, push, pull, unnecessarily splash swimmers, or cause undue disturbance/conduct that may endanger the welfare of self or other patrons.
14. Emergency procedures must be observed. Swimmers must leave the pool area immediately upon the signal or request of the Pool Manager.
16. Edge of the pool must be cleared of all sunbather/swimmers to prevent tripping hazards and access by lifeguards in the event of an emergency.
17. No person may use the pool unless it is officially open and the lifeguards are on duty.
18. The pool manager/lifeguard may close the pool for lifeguard breaks, safety, and/or maintenance reasons.

Lifeguards have final authority to ensure all policies and rules are adhered to in order to provide all patrons with a safe and enjoyable swimming experience.
