Access to electronic resources and databases requires a login and password. Please call 777-3833 for assistance. You will need to be a registered library user.

AUDIO-BOOK DOWNLOADS - This is very easy to use, browse, check out, and download digital media to your PC. This collection is available any time of day from anywhere in the world.

AUTO REPAIR REFERENCE CENTER - Provides detailed repair manuals for many makes and models of automobiles.

BIOGRAPHY RESEARCH CENTER - Contains a collection of more than 450,000 full-text biographies.

EBSCOHOST - A one stop resource for research with access to academic journals, magazines, and periodicals.

FIRST SEARCH - Go to "Databases" at this site to access World Almanac, *WilsonSelectPlus* for full-text articles on many subjects; GPO for Government publications, ERIC for Education Journals, News Abstracts for national and regional news, Media Review Digest; BusIndustry provides business information and statistics.

FOOTNOTE - HISTORY AND GENEALOGICAL ARCHIVES - Footnote helps you find historic documents through partnerships with The National Archives, the Library of Congress, and other institutions.

HOBBIES AND CRAFTS - Provides comprehensive content for many of the most popular crafts, hobbies, and recreation activities today.

INTERNATIONAL SECURITY AND COUNTER-TERRORISM REFERENCE CENTER - Offers information on virtually every dimension of security and counter-terrorism.

GALE - INFOTRAC - This meta-site contains databases with articles from journals, magazines, and newspapers from 1980's to the present, many with full text online.

JANE'S ONLINE - Jane's is a unique website that provides comprehensive information about military equipment, technology, history, tactics, and logistics, for military forces worldwide.
